BMP Title:	Paint and Paint Removal
BMP Description:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Paint and materials are to be transported to and from job sites in containers with secure lids and tied down to the vehicle.• Do not transfer or load paint near storm drain inlets or waterways.• Spray equipment is to be tested and inspected prior to starting to paint. Tighten all hoses and connections and do not overfill paint container.• Nearby storm drain inlets are to be plugged prior to starting painting in areas where there is a significant risk of a spill reaching the drain. Remove plugs when the job is complete.• Storm drain inlets are to be covered prior to sand blasting.• If a bridge crosses a waterway work should be performed on a maintenance traveler, platform or over suspended netting or tarps to capture paint, rust, paint removing agents or other materials to prevent discharge of materials to surface waters. If sanding, use a sander with a vacuum filter bag.• Capture all cleanup water and dispose of properly.• Unused paint will be taken to the Monroe County Household Hazardous Waste Facility.
